In Professor Derek Gilroy's lab, our research focuses on how inflammation 'switches off'. Using a model of acute, self-resolving inflammation, we have various studies ongoing looking at immune responses in healthy volunteers, patients with autoimmune disease, as well as older people (aged over 65 years). The model involves injecting a dead bacteria (UV-killed *E. coli*) into both forearms of our participants and sampling the site of inflammation and blood tests to look for differences in...
